- ___ 4. Use one of the 50 best FREE fonts from 2011 as named by [smashingapps.com](#) on your next layout! - 1 pt
- ___ 5. Use the simple and clean design of the Neighborhood Studio's [website](#) to inspire the composition of your next page. - 1 pt
- ___ 6. Take inspiration from [this art piece](#) from Creative Works by Connie to create an "ABC's of You" Layout. Fee free to create this layout about yourself or someone else... be creative! - 2 pts
- ___ 7. Use [this photo](#) of a table setting as a sketch for an original layout. - 1 pt
- ___ 8. Big titles are FUN! Take inspiration from [this cool print](#) by Jenny Bowers to create a LO with your own big, stamped title! - 1 pt
- ___ 9. Let's do a Paper-to-Digi scraplift using Larissa Albernaz's [amazing gallery](#) as inspiration. - 1 pt
- ___ 10. Be inspired by [this amazing video](#) to scrap a page using geometric paper piecing to cover the entire background. - 1 pt
- ___ 11. When I first started scrapbooking back in high school, speech bubble stickers were super popular. Use a speech bubble (or more!) on a layout. - 1 pt
- ___ 12. Laura Deieterich is known for writing a thank you note a day on her blog, [www.thxthxthx.com](#). Read through some of them for inspiration, then write your own thank you note and use it on a layout. - 2 pts
- ___ 13. Use [these photos](#) as an inspiration for a color palette on a layout. We're looking for most white with small pops of bright and happy color. - 1 pt
- ___ 14. I had to laugh when I saw [these pictures](#). When I met my husband and for the first few years we were married, he considered himself a "social coffee drinker." However, I soon learned that the ONLY reason he drank coffee was to watch it change colors when he poured the cream in. Use some quirky trait of your or someone in your family as a basis for a layout. - 1 pt

- ___ 23. Use [frames](#) to frame anything BUT photos! - 1 pt
- ___ 24. Use heart elements or create ones with paper & make your layout background filled with hearts. - 1 pt
- ___ 25. Instead of a title, [create a monogram](#) and use that as the focal point of your layout. - 1 pt
- ___ 26. Use this article from [clickinmoms](#) to inspire your food photography. Scrap a page about FOOD! - 1 pt
- ___ 27. Use [this image](#), "Places I Haven't Been" as inspiration to scrap a layout about travel, whether you have been there, or not. - 1 pt
