

- ___ 1. Create a hybrid Gratitude Album filled with things in life that you are thankful for. Must be at least 5 pages. See a sample by Juli here. - 10 pts.
- ___ 2. Use one of these prompts for your next scrapbook page. - 1 pt per LO for up to 5 points.
- ___ 3. Scrap about an event that hasn't made it into your scrapbooks yet. - 1 pt.
- ___ 4. Use the 30 Day Photo Challenge: Gratitude ideas to take a photo and scrap a layout. - 2 pts.
- ___ 5. Circles circles everywhere! Be inspired by this layout and scrap a page with at least 5 circles. Fill them with paper, photos, cut them out...anything! - 1 pt.
- ___ 6. Photo portrait idea: Shoot the details of your subjects and make them into triptychs! Then scrap it! - 2 pts.
- ___ 7. Be inspired by this awesome LO to use a BIG number on the background of a page as part of the title. - 1 pt.
- ___ 8. Use this artwork as inspiration to create a LO with geometric shapes and fall colors. - 1 pt.
- ___ 9. I love the valentine's decorations in this house! Be inspired by the pictures to create a LO with lots of red and lots of hearts! - 1 pt.
- ___ 10. What are you grateful for? Create a LO where you journal about things you are grateful for right now. - 2 pts.
- ___ 11. I recently found www.emergencycompliment.com from The Digishow and had a blast reading through the various compliments archived there! Use this site (the design or a compliment) as inspiration for a layout. - 1 pt.
- ___ 12. "Did you know..." Use this prompt as a springboard for a layout. - 1 pt.
- ___ 13. Thought Questions offers up various queries guaranteed to make me stop and really think. Use any one of them as a journal prompt for a layout. - 2 pts.
- ___ 14. Eclectic is definitely in! This blog post has some cool ideas on using clashing print patterns on a layout. Try a technique (or two) on a layout of your own! - 2 pts.
- ___ 15. Have you checked out the Sweet Shoppe Tutorial blog? There are plenty of ideas for layouts for both beginning and more advanced scrappers. Use at least one technique/idea from a tutorial on a layout. Don't forget to link to the tut in your credits! - 1 pt.
- ___ 16. Use this home decor project as inspiration for a page, including using a large monogram. - 1 pt.
- ___ 17. Create a new shape on your page using circle elements. - 1 pt.
- ___ 18. Use this infographic to scrap about a way that being introverted or extroverted has affected your life (for good or for bad!) - 1 pt.

- ___ 19. Scrap about your relationship with your mom or your relationship (as a mom) with your child. - 1 pt.
- ___ 20. This is such a cool tradition: Having the kids bag up toys that are still in good condition and then leaving them for Santa to take before he brings new toys. Scrap about a special Christmas tradition in your family — one you already do or one that you would like to start. - 1 pt.
- ___ 21. Use one of these sayings on a layout. You can make up to 3 layouts total using a different saying for each layout. - 1 pt per layout, for up to 3 points total.
- ___ 22. Scrap your holiday bucket list for any upcoming holiday you wish. - 1 pt.
- ___ 23. Be inspired by this super cute Goal List and scrap at least 4 of your current goals. - 1 pt.
- ___ 24. Have some fun with your journaling. Be inspired by this unique layout by Gina Miller and mix at least 5 elements or pieces of word art in to your journaling. - 1 pt.
- ___ 25. Use these peacock inspired colors to create a layout using any topic you'd like. - 1pt.
- ___ 26. It is that time of year! Take photos and make your 2012 Christmas card. - 2 pts.
- ___ 27. There is something so magical about SNOW! For this challenge, use the theme of snow for your layout. It must contain the colors white, blue, and silver, and of course have snow somewhere on the layout. If you don't have snow in your area, get creative! Scrap about your view of snow, how every snowflake is unique, just like someone you know, etc. - 1 pt.
- ___ 28. Create a layout with a wish list... could be yours, could be someone else's. Could be Christmas, could be about the world. Get creative! - 1 pt.
- ___ 29. Today is a historical day in the United States...Election Day. Use the phrase **I VOTE FOR...** as a title on your layout to tell about something you are passionate about, love, or a current event that may be happening. - 1 pt.
- ___ 30. It seems like templates are a must for most scrappers these days. For this challenge you can use ANY template by a Sweet Shoppe Designer, but there is a twist...you must flip it, spin it, shrink it, enlarge it, mirror it, combine more than one, anything you can think of to alter the template to make it completely your own. Think outside the template! - 2 pts.
- ___ 31. Christmas is coming - are you all caught up? Scrap holiday photos from a past year, using less-traditional holiday colors. - 2 pts.
- ___ 32. It's time for an old school Paper to Digi challenge! Use this paper layout by jen kinkade as inspiration for your digi layout. - 1pt.
- ___ 33. Inspiraton can come from anywhere! Think outside the box and pull inspiration from a non-scrap-booking source - think product packaging, websites, etc. - 2 pts.
- ___ 34. It's time to tackle your photos. Scrap a layout featuring a photo that you've been intimidated to scrapbook. - 1pt.

- ___ 35. Let's get paper happy! Use this image as inspiration for creating a shape using a variety of different papers. - 1pt.
