

- ___ 1. Create a hybrid holiday advent/countdown calendar for Halloween, Christmas or any special day. Get creative and make it from a cookie sheet, a premade set of drawers like this or any other inspiration you find from around the web! - 10 pts.
- ___ 2. Halloween is my FAVORITE holiday and Chasing Fireflies is my favorite place to look for costumes each year. Create a layout documenting this year's search for the perfect costumes for you, your little ones or even a friend! - 2 pts.
- ___ 3. This stylized ruler "growth chart" is such an awesome idea to make a common family tradition even more special! Create a layout documenting a ritual or tradition that is meaningful to your family. - 2 pts.
- ___ 4. There are 33 gorgeously photographed cupcakes and their recipes on display at Ming Makes Cupcakes. Make one and scrap it! - 2 pts.
- ___ 5. I'm feelin' hot for hybrid this month, and I just adore these darling and easy to make photo holders made from common binder clips. Make 1 or several, it's up to you. - 1 point per clip up to 5 points
- ___ 6. Use one of these spooky fonts (they are all free!) to create a frightfully fabulous LO. - 1pt.
- ___ 7. I love this perspective! Take a photo from above - looking down at your subject - and scrap it! - 1 pt.
- ___ 8. I love a lot of different things about this living room, but especially the way the base is pretty neutral (shade of blues) and there is a big POP of color. Take inspiration from this to create a LO using the same idea. - 1 pt.
- ___ 9. Here is a fun way to use lots of patterned paper! Be inspired by this quilt to use lots of skinny paper strips along the edge(s) of your page. - 2 pts.
- ___ 10. I am SO inspired by this photo -- are you? Create a LO that uses 1) a shape, 2) the outline of that shape and 3) the same shape somehow stamped on your page! Have fun! - 2 pts.
- ___ 11. Use this fun weekly calendar as inspiration for a layout about a typical week in your house. - 1 pt.
- ___ 12. Create a layout about some of the things you are hoping lay ahead of you. - 1 pt. If you use this quote on your layout. - 2 pts.
- ___ 13. You can't spend more than about 30 seconds on Pinterest without seeing some fall recipe. Create a layout about some of the fall foods you love and look forward to. - 1 pt.
- ___ 14. I love all the bright colors and the mixed use of polka dots and stripes. Use this image as an inspiration for your own happy, stripy, and polka-dotted layout! - 1 pt.
- ___ 15. Oh how I love these mugs! The all-white with a huge pop of color just makes my heart happy. Create a layout inspired by these colors -- lots of white with big bursts of color! - 1 pt.
- ___ 16. Love this mix of paint with photos and what appear to be magazine pages! Create a layout inspired by these collages. - 1pt.
- ___ 17. Part of the fun of the holidays is settling down to watch favorite flicks. What are your (or your family's) favorite holiday films? Scrap a layout about them. - 1 pt.
- ___ 18. Check out this blog post on how to create a scrapbook layout inspired by an infographic--and try your hand at it! - 2 pts.
- ___ 19. Use one of these Dr. Seuss quotes as a journaling prompt or title on a layout (or 3)! - 1 pt. per layout.

- ___ 20. Use [this](#) as a prompt for a layout: how are you NOT like everyone else? Then turn at least one element in your layout upside-down :) - 1 pt.
- ___ 21. Fall colors mixed with a pop of turquoise creates a more modern looking fall color palette. Use [this photo](#) as color inspiration and create a layout that includes at least four of the colors featured above. - 1 pt.
- ___ 22. This blog shares [8 simple rules for mixing patterns](#). Use these rules to create a fun layout that includes all the following patterns: Plaid, Houndstooth, Polka Dots, Stripes & One big bold pattern of choice. - 1 pt.
- ___ 23. Journal Challenge: be inspired by the website, [Not Always Related](#), which allows readers to contribute funny little stories about their families and friends. Create a layout that is mostly journaling that features a funny story about your family or friends. - 1 pt.
- ___ 24. [Morning, Noon & Night](#) - Create a layout that shows what goes on in your life by using the theme Morning, Noon and Night - pick one of those times of day and focus on what happens in your life, examples - What do you do, what do you wear, what do you eat, who are you with, etc. You can do this for one day or several days - whatever tickles your fancy. Create up to 3 layouts (one morning, one noon and one night) for 1 point each, for a max total of 3 points. - 1 pt. each / 3 points max
- ___ 25. Sweetest Day is October 20th this year - create a layout about something in your life that you think is pretty darn sweet. - 1 pt.
- ___ 26. Seasons Change... Use this [photo board](#) as inspiration for the current season you are in. It can be the season and weather around you, or even the season of life you are in. Get creative! Use block design and multiple photos. - 2 pts.
- ___ 27. [Tops list](#). I love to remember the best, or top things happening in our lives. Create a layout with at least 10 Top things right now. - 1 pt.
- ___ 28. Make your [fall bucket list!](#) Be inspired by this list, take action, and record your adventures! Scrap a page about 1, or up to 3 items from the list. - 1 pt. each
- ___ 29. Scraplift the amazing [crystalbella77](#). Her designs are so unique and amazing! - 1 pt.
- ___ 30. I recently traveled to another country. It was an amazing experience, and made me so grateful for the things I have. For this challenge, scrap about a place that has changed you... whether it be a plane ride away, or right in your own backyard. Include all of the details! - 2 pts.
- ___ 31. Does your home design style match your scrapbooking style? Choose a favorite element from a home design you love and use it as inspiration for your layout. - 1 pt.
- ___ 32. It's time to find your [focus](#). Use papers or elements in a creative way on your layout to draw the reader's eye to the most important part of the page. - 2 pts.
